

THE IRELAND POTATO FAMINE & THE UNITED STATES QUEST FOR FREEDOM.

On our pilgrimage to the beautiful green Ireland, where we visited the famous apparition site of Our Lady of Knock, we stopped at a town called Strokestown.

There was an interesting museum there that highlighted the Potato famine. I was very surprised that the Potato famine museum in Strokestown, Ireland, revealed much about the roots of the USA. The museum was built by the great-great grandchildren of Major Denis Mahon who was assassinated by starving tenants being evicted off the property. His descendants built the museum to convince the world that Denis Mahon was not such a bad person. However, the laws that were passed by the British government produced difficult situations for everyone involved.

The United States is the greatest country in the history of the world. The Republic that our Founding Fathers set up helped break the tyranny of power hungry people that abused people by reducing them to objects.

When we take a look history, especially the 75 years of abusive laws that the King of England passed against the poor Irish Catholics, one can see the protection from this kind of abuse that is written into our Bill of Rights.

Year 33 AD Jesus Christ the Son of God gave Peter the Keys to the Kingdom of Heaven. This God given authority made Peter the first Pope (Matthew 16).

Year 432 St. Patrick brings the Good News of Jesus to Ireland and the country becomes Catholic.

Year 1531 AD. After the Pope refused King Henry VIII a second annulment, the King declared himself the Pope (Head of the Anglican church), because he was the earthly superpower of that time. The people of Ireland did not go along with this and labeled the move an usurper of rights.

England went on to set up many laws that would pressure the Irish people to give up their loyalty to Jesus and His representative the Pope and follow the king of England's religion.

Year 1635 - England declared many lands of Ireland were now the property of the king of England. If a landowner did not renounce their faith, they would give his castle and property to a Protestant.

Year 1649 - Arrival of English general Oliver Cromwell and his army. They came to Ireland to enforce these laws. One third of the population of Ireland died by famine, plague or the sword.

Year 1695 - Penal laws were passed. 1. Catholics could not bear arms. 2. Catholics could not educate their children. 3. Catholics could not own a horse worth more than 5 lbs.

Year 1697 – It was Illegal to be a Catholic Priest.
Year 1700 - Catholics could not own land more than ¼ acre. Landowners would raise rent on them and drive them into poverty.

Year 1728 - Catholics could not vote. They tried to resist but their rusty guns no longer worked.

MEDIA - Irish people were portrayed to be pigs, dirty, lazy and uneducated.

The media would not report that the laws kept them poor unless they renounced God and God's representative.

Year 1776 AD - England was abusing the Americans also and America declared it's independence. They declare it is God who gives us rights of life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness and it is God who is going to help America defeat this superpower. Included in America's Bill of rights is the right to bear arms, freedom of speech, freedom of religion, freedom of the press, and a number of other rights that keep a tyrant from abusing the people.

Year 1829 - *Catholic emancipation or Catholic relief.* Due to pressure from the USA and other countries, England agreed to remove the official laws against Catholics. Since that time, they passed several laws that sounded nice, but did not describe the actual purpose of the law to persecute the poor.

Year 1838 AD – *Poor Law is passed.* England says they will help the poor by providing “work-houses.” They were really slave labor concentration camps to get the poor off the land to go and die.

1845 to 1849 the Potato famine hit Ireland. They would not let the Irish people eat the other food, because it belonged to the king. They removed the harvest by gunpoint so the people would starve. It was found later that the gift of Guano fertilizer, bird poop imported from Peru, caused the plague.

Also, the potato fields close to the copper sulfate facility were plighted free but British scientists did not develop the copper cure until later.

1846 AD - The USA sends over 25,000 tons of corn feed the starving people.

1846 AD - England made a new law called, **“The right of free trade act.”** It sounded nice, but it prevented the USA from giving free food to hungry people. Many people starved to death.

Ireland’s population dropped from 8 to 2 1/2 million by death or emigration. They wanted the people gone so the land could be used for cattle.

1922 AD – Ireland gained independence.

USA’s turn. In light of this abuse, the United States was also under the British rule. The Bill of Rights is an important protector for the citizens. The US Constitution is a “Tyrant Breaker.”

USA - Declaration of Independence, July 4, 1776

Is actually a short but powerful document. The USA calls on God three times by proclaiming God is the Creator, Judge, and Provider of our freedom.

There were five parts to proclaim the reason to the rest of the world why the USA was declaring independence.

1. “The obvious truths are that all men are created equal and they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights that among these are life, liberty and pursuit of happiness.”
2. “The purpose of government is to secure these rights.” (Note, not to give them, failure to do so means to change.)

3. (Abuses of present government.) “The history of the present King of Great Britain is a history of repeated injuries and usurpations, all having in direct object the establishment of an absolute tyranny over these states. To prove this, let facts be submitted to a candid world.” (List of 29 facts to show the world his tyranny, including murdering citizens, deprivation of trial by jury, imposing tax without consent, tyrant in making laws, forcing people to let the army stay in their homes).
4. “We, therefore, the representatives of USA, appealing to the Supreme Judge of the world (God),, (we) ought to be free,,,”
5. “To support this declaration (against the superpower of the world, England) we have firm reliance on the protection of Divine Providence”, (God).

Representatives from the 13 states sign the Declaration of Independence.

July 4, the YEAR OF OUR LORD, 1776. That Lord is Jesus Christ, by the way. We have no doubt as to what God they were referring to.

The Muslims would not sign their documents using AD. The French Revolution outlawed God in 1792 and called it Year 1 of Liberty. They would not acknowledge Jesus Christ as Lord.

The Bill of Rights include: Freedom of Religion. Freedom of speech. Freedom of the press. Freedom of assembly. Freedom of petition. Right to bear arms. These are all the rights that England took away from the Irish between 1695 to 1829 in order to suppress them.

The United States Constitution was issued in September 17, 1787. “We the people in order to form a more perfect union...”

Our Country empowers “We the people” with a rule that protects all citizens. We still encounter problems, but they are our problems and we must fix them. The Constitution gives us that power. The system of checks and balances keeps tyrants and the elitists from taking over. Representatives are elected to uphold our Constitution. It made us the greatest country the world has ever seen.

The USA is the primary force to prevent dictators of Communism from controlling the world. They will do everything to trick us into giving up our Constitution. For 100 years, they have been causing agitations and divisions with “AGITPROP” so they can divide and conquer.
